What's happening in February?

Literacy: Children have started reading emergent texts, with a focus on using the pictures and tapping out CVC words. Reading strategies will be explored in the coming months.

Math: During math, we have practiced writing and representing teen numbers. Our next unit will be about place value and using base-IO blocks to represent those numbers.

Fundations: We are now on Unit 3. One focus is reading nonsense words, which are silly words that show that they can read the sounds. Long vowel sounds will be introduced

Science: We have been learning about weather using Freckle and Okapi. We will continue to talk about weather predictions. We have a mini science program happening virtually this week as well.

A Quick Reminder:

Please continue to work with your child on their fact fluency flash cards. Having a strong foundation of these facts helps in solving addition and subtraction problems.
